The winner of the Best Newcomer award was presented to Blaengelli in Carmarthenshire. Blaengelli is a family farm, farmed by Mr Roger and Mrs Catherine Howells and daughters, Sarah being the eldest and the youngest daughter Emma on call when needed. The 320 acre farm have 150 Holsteins which over the past two the herd has suffered quite severely with TB. The herd average yield is 11500 litres, with the cows being milked twice a day, housed all year round and fed on a partial TMR with compound fed in the parlour. The dry cows have a six week dry period, cubicle housed, fed a complete TMR.
